Introduction

Song Writing. How to Start?

Pick up a pencil.

Songs and poems don't just happen for most people, they require practice, motivation, dedication, inspiration, and perspiration. Inspiration needs an invitation. That is what this book is about. Students develop their ideas and a rhyming vocabulary. A rhyming vocabulary also develops reading and writing skills. This is the fun way to improve reading and writing skills.

Learn, Discover, Explore, Create.

Students who complete the activities in this book will improve their song writing skills. Many will write their own songs and poetry. Reading and writing will improve dramatically.

The book is easy to use. The activities follow the same design. After students complete the first activity, they understand how all the lessons work.

Program Benefits:

- ① Recent research shows that rhythm and rhyme promote dopamine production in the reward centers of the brain.
- ① RAP Rhythms can have a powerful learning effect on the brain.
- ① Developing poetic and musical talents improves reading and writing skills.
- ① Learn to rhyme, express emotions and ideas, and make songs flow!

Presenting the Book

ACTIVITY 1:

Students read and discuss the meanings of the rap starter songs.

(Ask WHY and WHAT IF questions.)

It is best to work in pairs or groups. Students take more chances, more fun.

ACTIVITY 2:

Students write a part to the song or add some interesting lines. They can also repeat lines. They can refer to the rhyming word dictionary in the appendix. While the rhyming words are listed by songs, they can use all of the words as a reference for any song. They write in the box at the bottom of the Rap Starter.

When done students read the rap and their part in a rhythmic way. This makes a stronger imprint on the brain and opens creative channels. It is prosody, which is how you say and emphasize different parts of the song for meaning. They can also add music.

ACTIVITY 3:

Students write a rap about the theme in the circle. They write down the ideas for their rap on the lines around the circle. This is *Free Association* and helps build a lyric. It is sometimes called a word web. On the lines around the circle, they write words that have a similar sound, a similar meaning, a different meaning, or words they like.

They think of rhyming words that go with their song idea and write them on the lines at the top. Searching for a rhyme often ignites the imagination in unexpected directions.

There is also a list of rhyming words related to each song in the appendix. *The book: **Reading, Writing, Rappin' Dictionary*** is also recommended as it contains thousands of school-related rhyming words in consistent spelling patterns.

ACTIVITY 4:

Students write their song ideas in the box at the bottom. These can be just rhyming phrases or songs of their ideas. Get pairs or groups to share their ideas. They take more chances and have more fun. Some students may prefer to work on their own at times. Always have them save their work and say their ideas in a rhythmic way, add music.

The book can be adapted to different ways to present the lessons. Going through the lessons in sequence offers more improvement for spelling and writing.

Another activity to develop ideas is taking two words and thinking of ways they go together. Here is an example I did with the words **water** and **mirror**.
